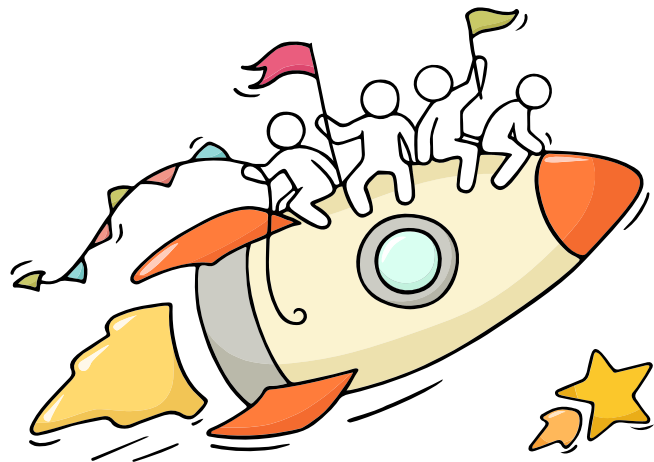

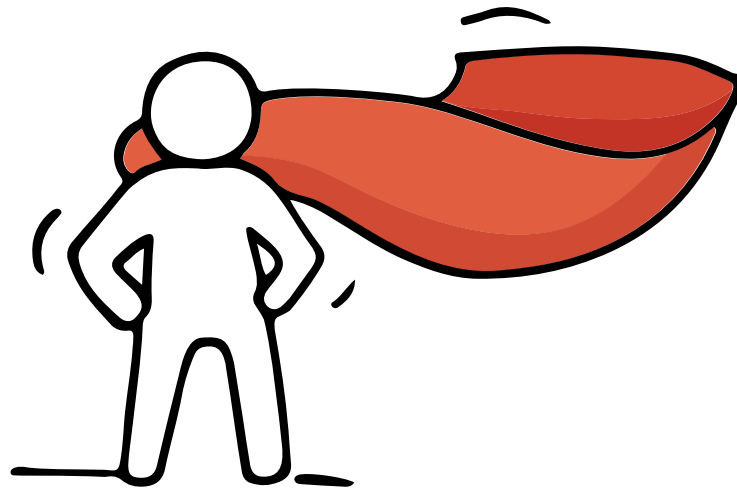

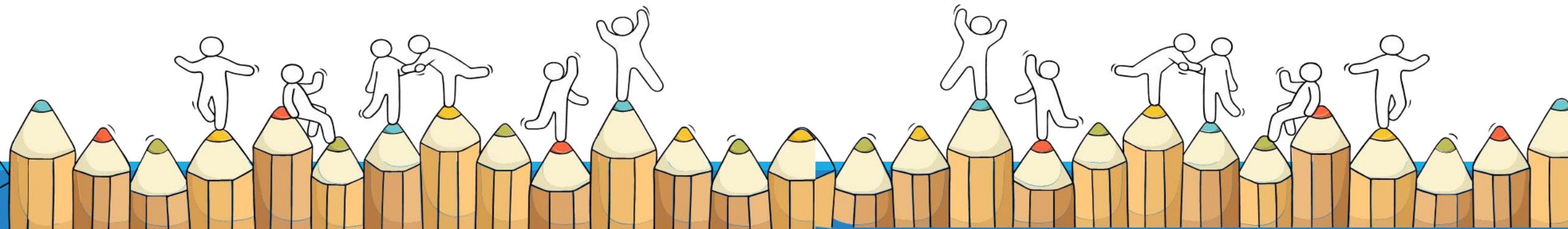
- Approach a trusted adult and seek his/her help. Have a conversation with this person about what would be best for you.

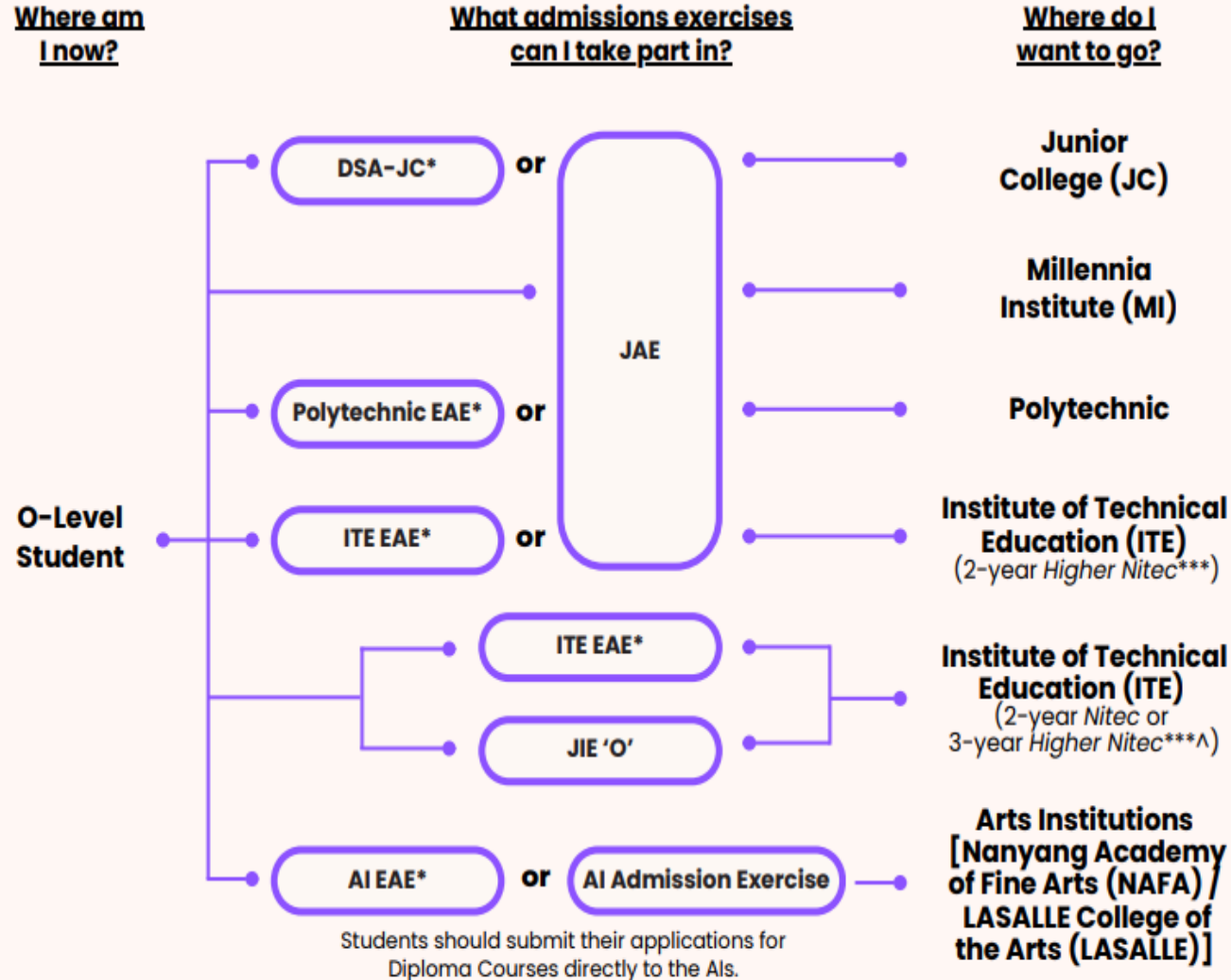

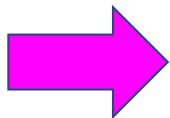

JAE Posting Procedure

JAE Posting is based on:

Net Aggregate Score

- **Net** score = **Gross** score (Form A) **minus bonus points**

Course Choices & Order

Vacancies Available in the Courses



- **Academic Merit** is the first criterion.
- Applicants with **Lower Net Score** will be considered for admission **first**.
- This is then followed by order of course choices by the applicant, subject to vacancies remaining.

Posting Results

- The posting results of the JAE application are scheduled for release on **Tuesday, 4 February 2025** through the following modes:
 - a. Short Message Service (SMS) to the Singapore mobile phone number provided by the applicant during application
 - b. JAE-IS, which is accessible through the JAE website

DSA/ EAE Matters

- Students successfully admitted to a school through the DSA-JC / EAE will **not** be able to participate in JAE.
- Students who do not meet the JC/polytechnic admission criteria may take part in the JAE to apply for other courses which they are eligible for.

Reporting to posted institutions

- Applicants posted to JCs and MI are to report to their posted institutions on Wednesday, 5 February 2025.
- Applicants posted to polytechnics will receive an email with enrolment details by end-February 2025.
- Applicants posted to ITE will receive an email with enrolment details by Tuesday, 4 February 2025.

Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP) – 4NA students

- PFP-eligible students will receive a copy of Form P with their PFP PIN for the PFP Admissions Exercise (PFPAE) portal
- Interested students to submit their applications online via the PFP website at [PFP Joint Admissions Exercise – Application](#)
- **Applications for the PFP will be open from: 1.30pm on Friday, 10 January 2025, to 4.00pm on Wednesday, 15 January 2025.**
- The **PFP posting results** will be released at **1.30pm on Wednesday, 22 January 2025** through the PFP website.
- Students will thereafter be required to indicate whether they wish to accept, reject, or appeal for a change of course **by 4.00pm on Monday, 27 January 2025.**

Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP) – 4NA students

- Eligible Secondary 4 N(A) students may submit their DPP applications online via the DPP application portal at [For GCE 'N' Students \(DPP\) \(JIE 'H'\)](#)
- Applications for the DPP will open from **Friday, 10 January 2025, to Tuesday, 14 January 2025.**
- The DPP posting results will be released at **on Friday, 17 January 2025** through the DPP application portal. Students will be required to indicate whether they wish to accept or reject the DPP offer **by Tuesday, 21 January 2025.**

Successful PFP/ DPP Applicants

– 4NA students

- The last day of school for Secondary 5 students who have accepted a place in the **PFP** will be on **Monday, 27 January 2025**. Students will be informed by the respective polytechnics on the enrolment dates for the PFP.
- Students who have accepted a place in the earlier application phase of the DPP in December but decide to take up a PFP offer now must withdraw from the DPP first before they are able to take up the PFP offer. DPP-enrolled students should check with their ITE class advisor for more details on the DPP withdrawal process and deadlines for withdrawal.

- You must collect the appeal form from GO, submit the appeal and pay appeal fees latest by **Wednesday, 15 January 2025.**
- If you have questions on retention matters, please see Vice-Principal Ms Lim in the GO after collecting results.
