- Remember that the O-Level is one part of your life journey and not the destination.


Do

When you receive your results, you may experience a range of emotions.


Managing these emotions well will allow you to stay calm and make rational decisions.



 Score will be considered for admission first.
- This is then followed by order of course choices by the applicant, subject to vacancies remaining.

Posting Results

- The posting results of the JAE application are scheduled for release on Tuesday, 4 February 2025 through the following modes:
 - a. Short Message Service (SMS) to the Singapore mobile phone number provided by the applicant during application
 - b. JAE-IS, which is accessible through the JAE website

DSA/ EAE Matters

- Students successfully admitted to a school through the DSA-JC / EAE will **not** be able to participate in JAE.
- Students who do not meet the JC/polytechnic admission criteria may take part in the JAE to apply for other courses which they are eligible for.

Reporting to posted institutions

• Applicants posted to JCs and MI are to report to their posted institutions on Wednesday, 5 February 2025.

•Applicants posted to polytechnics will receive an email with enrolment details by end-February 2025.

•Applicants posted to ITE will receive an email with enrolment details by Tuesday, 4 February 2025.

Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP) - 4NA students

- PFP-eligible students will receive a copy of Form P with their PFP PIN for the PFP Admissions Exercise (PFPAE) portal
- Interested students to submit their applications online via the PFP website at PFP Joint Admissions Exercise Application
- Applications for the PFP will be open from: 1.30pm on Friday, 10 January 2025, to 4.00pm on Wednesday, 15 January 2025.
- The PFP posting results will be released at 1.30pm on Wednesday, 22 January
 2025 through the PFP website.
- Students will thereafter be required to indicate whether they wish to accept, reject, or appeal for a change of course **by 4.00pm on Monday, 27 January 2025.**

Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP) – 4NA students

- Eligible Secondary 4 N(A) students may submit their DPP applications online via the DPP application portal at <u>For GCE 'N' Students (DPP)</u> (JIE 'H')
- Applications for the DPP will open from <u>Friday</u>, <u>10 January 2025</u>, <u>to</u>
 <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>14 January 2025</u>.
- The DPP posting results will be released at <u>on Friday, 17 January</u>
 <u>2025</u> through the DPP application portal. Students will be required to indicate whether they wish to accept or reject the DPP offer <u>by</u>
 <u>Tuesday, 21 January 2025.</u>

Successful PFP/ DPP Applicants – 4NA students

- The last day of school for Secondary 5 students who have accepted a place in the **PFP** will be on **Monday, 27 January 2025.** Students will be informed by the respective polytechnics on the enrolment dates for the PFP.
- Students who have accepted a place in the earlier application phase of the DPP in December but decide to take up a PFP offer now <u>must</u> <u>withdraw from the DPP first before they are able to take up the PFP offer.</u> DPP-enrolled students should check with their ITE class advisor for more details on the DPP withdrawal process and deadlines for withdrawal.

- You may request for a re-print of your certificate only if your name was printed wrongly due to misspelling.
- SEAB charges an amendment fee of \$50 for each certificate that requires a re-print.
- Pls see Ms Ifah/ Ms Christina Lee in the General Office after release of results.

Results-Related Admin Matters

- You can request for an appeal to SEAB for review of results
 - you will be informed of the outcome via a letter. No report on your performance will be provided.
 - SEAB charges a fee of \$114.45 per subject.
- You must collect the appeal form from GO, submit the appeal and pay appeal fees latest by <u>Wednesday</u>, 15 January 2025.
- If you have questions on retention matters, please see Vice-Principal Ms Lim in the GO after collecting results.
