Dear Parents/ Guardians

We hope the girls had a good break during the March holidays. In this letter, we will be sharing information and updates on school matters, as well as upcoming events in Term 2.

1. Holistic Development of Students

Programmes in Term 1 such as Orientation, Total Defence Day, Sports Day, Values-in-Action projects and Honours Day all contribute to the holistic development of students and are part of the KC experience.
