Dear Parents/ Guardians

We hope that you and your daughter/ward are having a good March break. In this letter, we will be sharing information on school matters, as well as upcoming events in Term 2. Term 2 starts on Tuesday, 24 March as Monday is a day off-in-lieu for schools. We wish all Muslim students and their families 'Selamat Hari Raya Aidilfitri' in advance.

1. **Holistic Development of Students**

Besides lessons and CCA, school programmes, such as Orientation, Level Camps and Total Defence Day, play a key role in students' holistic development. We would like to thank parent volunteers and alumni members for contributing to these programmes and all parents and guardians for your support.

On the last day of school in Term 1, students reviewed their learning goals and reflected on their learning experiences. The Term 1 results slips will be issued on Wednesday, 25 March, and we encourage you to continue conversations with your daughter/ward about her growth and aspirations. 2. **Key School Events in Term 2**

We are delighted to share that Term 2 will bring several school programmes such as Book and Music Week, Student-Initiated Learning, and Founder's Day celebrations which are highlighted below. a. **Temperature Taking Exercise**

To ensure that the school remains a safe environment for learning, students should seek medical attention when they are unwell and rest at home. As part of fostering personal and social responsibility, the school will conduct a Temperature Taking Exercise on Wednesday, 1 April. Please ensure that your daughter/ward brings a working thermometer on that day. Secondary 1 students will be issued a thermometer prior to the exercise.

b. **Book and Music Week (BMW)**

BMW is a cherished tradition at KC that nurtures students' appreciation and participation in the arts. Themed "To Bond with Gold", the event will take place from 7 to 9 April.

Starting from the ILD on 13 April, Secondary 1 to 3 students will follow their timetable until 12.30 p.m., after which they can work on their chosen SIL project. Through SIL, we aim to nurture students who are curious and self-directed and are prepared to be lifelong learners.

d. Founder's Day celebrations

We look forward to celebrating Founder's Day on Thursday, 28 May. It is an occasion to reflect on our theme this year, "Trust in the Lord and Do Good," and enable students to connect with the rich values and heritage that define our KC family.
